



## How to Set an Online Memorial's GPS Location

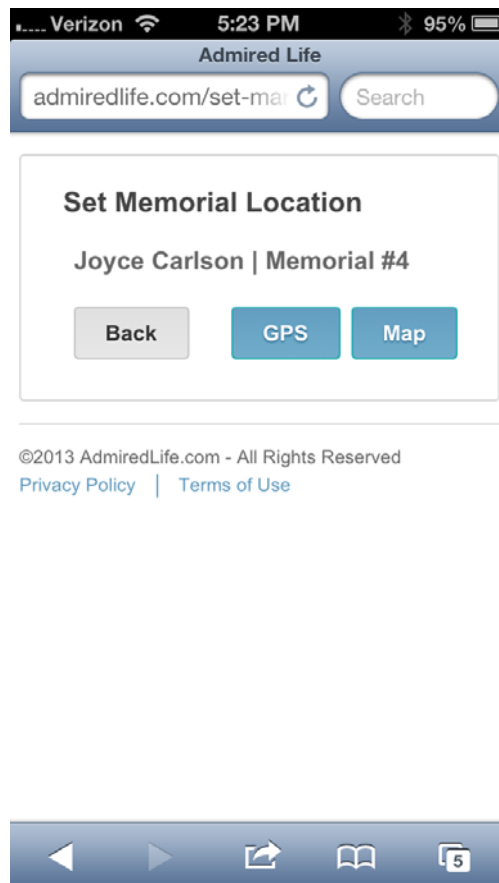
- Step 1.** Navigate on your smart phone's web browser to: [www.admiredlife.com/setgps](http://www.admiredlife.com/setgps) Your screen should look like this:

- Step 2.** On the **Redemption Certificate** or **Redemption Certificate E-Mail**, you will find the **Web Order Number** or the **Sales Order Number** and the **Last Name** of the memorialized person near the bottom.

Enter that number and the deceased last name and tap “**Search**”

**Step 3.** Now that you've found the memorial in our system, tap "GPS" to select the primary method of setting a memorial. See below:

**Step. 4** You are now at this screen. Stand at the memorial site and tap the “GPS” button. Please note the onscreen instructions.

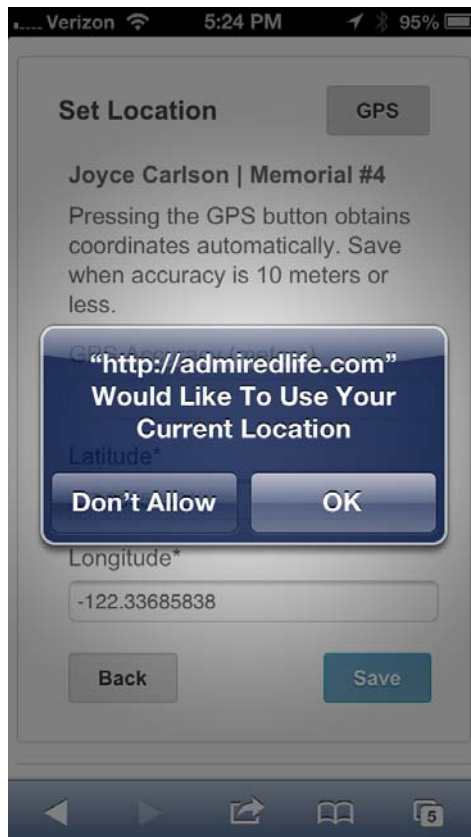

**Note:** This memorial doesn't have location data in the Latitude / Longitude fields. This means that this memorial has never had a location assigned to it. If there were numbers in those fields, you would be overwriting them in the database (which is okay to do).

- Step 5.** Often your smart phone will ask you for your permission to use your **Current Location**. This is a security feature. Approve the message or tap **“OK”**.



**Step 6.** After tapping the “OK” button, your phone will start the **GPS Polling Process** to collect an accurate location. When the accuracy meter drops to 10 meters or less – tap the “Save” button and you’ve just set the memorial’s location in the AdmiredLife system.

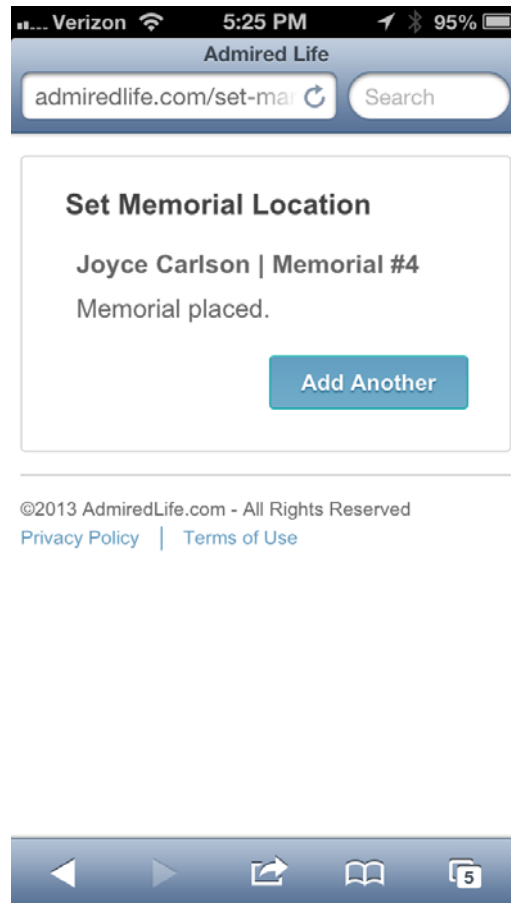

**Note:** You could choose “**Add Another**” if you were setting a companion memorial for a second person or checking your GPS setting using the “**Map**” function.



## Troubleshooting and Suggestions

1. My GPS doesn't work on my phone.
  - a. Make sure the GPS function of your phone is turned on.
    - i. For Android: Settings -> Security & Location -> Enable GPS Satellites
    - ii. For iPhone: Settings -> Privacy -> Location Services -> "On" and Safari "On"
2. My phones GPS isn't that accurate, how can I fine tune the setting location for the family?
